

## **TERMS OF USE AND PRIVACY POLICY**

### **Terms of use**

Access to and use of this site (biblefellowship.co.uk) is provided by the owner(s) of this site subject to the following terms:

## **Privacy Policy**

The following statement explains our policy regarding the personal information we collect about you.

### **1. Introduction**

This policy covers biblefellowship.co.uk's use of personal information that the owner(s) collect when you use biblefellowship.co.uk.

From time to time, you will be asked to submit personal information about yourself (e.g. name and email address) in order to receive or use services on our website. Such services may include newsletters, competitions, live chats, message boards and information to be compiled for petitioning as stated within biblefellowship.co.uk.

By entering your details in the fields requested, you enable biblefellowship.co.uk and its service providers to provide you with the services you select. Whenever you provide such personal information, we will treat that information in accordance with this policy. When using your personal information biblefellowship.co.uk will act in accordance with current legislation and aim to meet current Internet best practice.

### **2. Visitor Information**

During the course of any visit to biblefellowship.co.uk, the pages you see, along with a short text file called a 'cookie', are downloaded to your computer. Many websites do this, because cookies enable website publishers to do useful things like find out whether the computer (and probably its user) has visited the website before. This is done on a repeat visit by checking to see, and finding, the cookie left there on the last visit.

Information supplied by cookies can help us to provide you with a better online user experience and assist us to analyse the profile of our visitors.

### **3. What is a cookie?**

A cookie is a small amount of data, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier that is sent to your browser from a website's computer and stored on your computer's hard drive. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a web site to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites.

#### **4. Use and storage of your personal information**

When you supply any personal information to biblefellowship.co.uk (e.g. for the purposes of being contacted, or completing an online petition) we have legal obligations towards you in the way we use those data. We must collect the information fairly, that is, we must explain how we will use it (see the notices on particular webpages that let you know why we are requesting the information) and tell you if we want to pass the information on to anyone else.

In general, any information you provide to biblefellowship.co.uk will only be used within biblefellowship.co.uk and by its agents and service providers. Your information will be disclosed where we are obliged or permitted by law. Also, if you post or send offensive, inappropriate or objectionable content anywhere on or to biblefellowship.co.uk or otherwise engage in any disruptive behaviour on biblefellowship.co.uk, the owner(s) can use whatever information that is available to it about you to stop such behaviour. This may involve informing relevant third parties such as your employer, school e-mail/Internet provider and law enforcement agencies about the content and your behaviour.

We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as required for the stated purposes. For safety reasons, however, biblefellowship.co.uk may store messaging transcript data (including message content, names, email addresses, times and dates) arising from the use of biblefellowship.co.uk. We will ensure that all personal information supplied is held securely, in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

#### **5. Access to your personal information**

You have the right to request a copy of the personal information biblefellowship.co.uk holds about you and to have any inaccuracies corrected. There may be a nominal fee for this service to cover administrative costs and postage.

#### **6. Users 16 and under**

If you are aged 16 or under, please get your parent/guardian's permission beforehand whenever you provide personal information to biblefellowship.co.uk's website. Users without this consent are not allowed to provide us with personal information.
